Pharmexcil Leads Indian Pharma Delegation to Uzbekistan, Strengthens Bilateral Industry Ties

Tashkent, March 25, 2026: Pharmexcil led a delegation of 47 Indian pharmaceutical companies to Tashkent, Uzbekistan, for a Buyer–Seller Meet held on March 24–25, 2026 at Wyndham Tashkent. The event saw participation from over 90 Uzbek buyers, facilitating direct business interactions and exploring new partnership opportunities.

The inaugural session was graced by senior dignitaries from both countries. Shri Raja Bhanu, Director General, Pharmexcil, highlighted India’s global strength in supplying high-quality, affordable generic medicines and encouraged Indian companies to expand collaborations in Uzbekistan. Ambassador of India to Uzbekistan, emphasized the growing strategic partnership and the role of the pharmaceutical sector in enhancing bilateral trade. Mr. Abdulla Azizov, Chairman and First Deputy Minister of the Pharmaceutical Industry Development Agency, Government of Uzbekistan, outlined the country’s pharma policies and invited Indian firms to invest in manufacturing and technology partnerships.

The event featured one-on-one B2B meetings, enabling meaningful engagement between Indian exporters and Uzbek stakeholders. On March 25, a select delegation visited Pharma Park Tashkent, a rapidly developing pharmaceutical hub with integrated R&D, education, and manufacturing facilities. The park currently hosts several international companies, including five from India. Discussions during the visit focused on regulatory frameworks, investment opportunities, and strengthening industry cooperation.

The visit marks a significant step in deepening India–Uzbekistan pharmaceutical collaboration and fostering long-term business partnership.
